- (ac) <u>Numerical Ability</u>. Decimal Fraction, Time and Work, Average/Percentage, Profit & Loss, Ratio & Proportion, Simple and Compound Interest, Time & Distance and Races (Trains/ Boats & Streams), Area and Perimeter, Probability, Number System & Number Series, Mixture & Allegation Rules, Clocks.
- (ad) Reasoning and Military Aptitude Test. Verbal and Non-Verbal Reasoning
- (ii) <u>Standard</u>. The standard of Numerical Ability Questions will be of Matriculation level. The standard of questions in other subjects will be of graduation level (Indian University).
